

SCHOOL UNIFORM



COMPULSORY ITEMS DAYWEAR UNIFORM

- Grey knee length skirt or trouser
- Tiffin shirt (long and/or short sleeved)
- Tiffin blue jumper or cardigan (with Tiffin Girls' logo)
- Black regulation school shoes, preferably leather
- Plain, white socks (non-branded and not sports socks), 70-denier opaque black matt tights (not sheer black tights) or neutral-coloured nylon tights. (White socks/ankle socks or neutral-coloured tights may be worn during summer)
- Blue overall for Art/DT/science
- Name label on the inside of daywear items
- DT polyholdall (as advised)
- DT display file (as advised)
- DT stationery (as advised)
- Art sketchpad (as advised)

OTHER

- Plain dark colour coat or raincoat (excluding denim, leather or faux fur)
- Locker padlock
- Tiffin Girls' water bottle or non-single use plastic water bottle

COMPULSORY ITEMS PE KIT

- Tiffin branded skort
- Tiffin branded leggings
- Tiffin branded games top
- House t-shirt
- Tiffin branded hockey socks
- Sports trainers with laces
- Astro boots
- Gum shield
- Shin pads
- Zipped sports holdall with shoulder strap or two grab handles, durable fabric. Preferred size 46L x 27H x 27W cm. The size must not exceed 60L x 30W x 30H cm.
- Name label on the inside of PE kit
- Pack of hair bands/ties (if hair is longer than neck-length)

OPTIONAL ITEMS PE KIT

- Tiffin branded tracksuit top (half zip)
- Tiffin branded tracksuit trouser
- Tiffin branded tracksuit waterproof
- Tiffin branded white base layer top
- Black or white sweat bands (compulsory for girls with non-removable religious bands)
- Hockey stick and tennis racquet (or school supplies)

EMBROIDERY

- The blue Art/DT/science overall should have the student's first name embroidered across the back shoulders in white stitching, in capitals and measuring 30mm approximately, eg HANNAH.
- The house t-shirt has the embroidered house name on the front when purchased.

INTERNAL LABELLING (NAME LABEL)

- All items of uniform and PE kit should be labelled with your daughter's full name on the inside, for example inside the neck of shirts and inside the waist of skirts. Named items which have been lost and found can be collected from Lost Property which is run by the school office. If items are not labelled, they are kept for a short time and then disposed of – either given to charity or the PSA.

VALUABLES

- Students are permitted to bring valuables to school but have the responsibility of looking after them
- Students who cycle to school will be asked to complete a permission form in September. Bicycles should be padlocked and stored in the bicycle racks provided

PERSONAL APPEARANCE

- Skirts must be worn on the knee
- Shirts must be tucked in and skirts not rolled up
- Plain, white socks (non-branded and not sports socks), 70-denier opaque black matt tights (not sheer black tights) or neutral-coloured nylon tights must be worn with uniform
- Shoes must be black, preferably leather, and provide support and protection for the feet. These should be in a serviceable, sensible style without coloured decorations. Heels should be wide-based and not be more than 4cm high. Open toes, sling backs, platform soles, canvas shoes, trainers/trainer-style shoes and high or narrow heels are not permitted. Boots are also not to be worn in school
- Outdoor coats should be plain and dark in colour and are not to be worn around the school. Hoodies and sweatshirts are not to be worn in place of a coat. Leather jackets, denim jackets or faux furs are not acceptable as outdoor coats
- Jewellery worn must be discreet, such as a pair of small plain gold or silver circular stud earrings. The earrings must be a matching pair and only one earring may be worn in each ear. These must be removed for PE. No other piercings are allowed

- We recognise the diversity of our community; discreet, visible religious or cultural symbols will be individually considered on request of the parent to their daughter's Head of Year
- Hair must be kept in a neat style (whether loose or tied back) and should be of a natural hair colour. Extremes of hairstyle and unnatural bleaching or dyeing are not permitted
- Head coverings worn for religious reasons are permitted provided they are tied back for health and safety reasons. In Years 7-11 head coverings must be in school uniform colours (dark blue, grey or black). No other items of religious dress, including face coverings, are permitted
- Hair accessories may be any colour provided they are of a plain style and colour. Large or elaborate clips with flowers or other embellishments are not permitted, neither are scarves or bandanas tied around the head
- Make up or nail varnish must not be worn
- All girls must have a fastened bag or case for books and a sports holdall. Open bags, drawstring or carrier bags are not acceptable
- Students are not permitted to wear any aspect of their PE kit instead of their school uniform to normal lessons. Students attending fixtures midway through a lesson will be exempted if prior permission is given by PE staff
- A separate dress code applies for non-uniform days
